


4D Ambisonic sound enables the production of sound holograms vivid, spatial appearances of sound that enrich and transform our perception.



CAD top view with no fabric (left) & with fabric (right)













The Roots designed surrounding the performance space are inspired by the **Puna Trees** of the Amazon.
